

## Important Information: Please Read

The best access to the campsite is via the **Brogdale Road from the A2**. Please be aware of road closures that prevent you from getting onto Brogdale Road from junction 6 -Please come off the M2 at Junction 7 (Brenley Corner) onto the A2 and get to Brogdale Road from there. Only 5 minutes extra saving you a lot of stress. <u>https://www.roads.org.uk/motorway/m2/360</u>

- 1. The showers cost 50p for seven minutes, please bring some 50 pence pieces with you, all monies from the showers will go to replanting the lost cherry and damson trees on the farm and contribute to the new native hedging around the community centre land which the farm has donated to the village.
- 2. Check in is from 1pm. Check out is at Midday. You must have pitched up by 10pm to minimise disturbance. if you do arrive later please drive through the site quietly to the overflow field through the gate and pitch up until the morning and we will relocate or you may well enjoy staying there!
- 3. The pitch numbers on the booking system **do not** correspond to actual pitch numbers in the orchard. We will of course try our best to put family and friends close to each other we recommend arriving early in the afternoon to secure nearby pitches but it will all depend on the availability of spots on the day and the comings and goings of campers already booked in.
- 4. Max Pitch sizes are 8m x 5m to include your MH, van, vehicle and tent, and any extras awning, gazebo, pups etc if you think you need more space then please book an extra pitch.
- 5. The overflow field has plenty space for parking to give everyone as much space to enjoy their time on the farm we kindly ask if you could pop unneeded vehicles there.
- 6. All commercial vans and vehicles with sign writing **MUST** go in the overflow field to park.
- 7. Quiet time is from 11pm to 7am no noise or music please, chat quietly by all means but please respect other campers right to have an peaceful night under the stars.
- 8. Fire pits and BBQ's are allowed but must be off the ground. Firewood and kindling can be bought onsite for £5 a bag. We have TEN fire pits for hire at £5/night on a first come first served basis on the day.
- 9. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 10. Music must be off by 10.30pm. No loud or disruptive behaviour will be tolerated.
- 11. Visitors are allowed (within reason, no large groups) but must be off site by 9pm latest, please park outside the farm perimeter in the village or B roads.
- 12. Ball games in the overflow field please.

- 14. Only one car per pitch All extra cars and cars with pup tent bookings must go in the overflow field.
